INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING ARGUMENTS IN FAVOR OF OR AGAINST CITY MEASURES

California Elections Code Section 9281 allows registered voters to submit arguments in favor of or against any city measure being submitted to the voters. Each argument may have no more than five signatures. Arguments, along with a Argument and Rebuttal Form of Statement must be submitted to the City Clerk at Rolling Hills City Hall, 2 Portuguese Bend Road, Rolling Hills by 5:00 p.m on **July 10, 2017**.

Argument submissions should include the following:

- (1) Argument and Rebuttal Form of Statement (EC 9600) to include printed names and signatures of authors (EC 9283)
- (2) Title as noted below (EC 9282):
Argument in Favor of Measure ____*
Argument Against Measure ____* *or*
- (3) Text of argument not to exceed 300 words (EC 9282):
- (4) Electronic copy of text of argument in Microsoft Word

If more than one argument *for* or more than one argument *against* any measure is submitted to the City Clerk within the specified time frame, the City Clerk, per Elections Code Section 9287 shall select one of the arguments in favor and one of the arguments against the measure for printing and distribution to the voters. The following criteria is used for setting priority for which author's argument is selected:

1. The legislative body, or member or members of the legislative body authorized by that body
2. The individual voter, or bona fide association of citizens, or combination of voters and associations who are the bona fide proponents of the measure
3. Bona fide associations of citizens
4. Individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measure.
